

Church History 307 Associate Degree Level



Classroom Hours: 24 (minimum)

Description/Overview:

Beginning with a general view of church history this course deals with the founding and development of Pentecostalism. Students will learn about Pentecostal history from the Council of Nicea, to the Reformation, to the latter rain movement and the founding of the organization.

Objectives:

At the end of this course students will be able to:

- 1.) Summarize a brief overview of Pentecostal Church History.
- 2.) Divide and chart the history of Christianity into seven distinct periods.
- 3.) Compare church history to Biblical prophecy.
- 4.) Identify the two destroying agencies of the great falling out.
- 5.) Define the Council of Nicea and explain its influence on the Pentecostal movement.
- 6.) List some results of the falling away.
- 7.) State some of the preparations for reformation that were put into place.
- 8.) Highlight the restoration of the professing church.
- 9.) Expound upon some of the great revival movements in church history such as the Quaker, Shaker, and the revivals of Whitfield and Wesley.
- 10.) State some results of the Latter Rain.

Topics/Concepts:

- The presence of the gifts and fruit of the Holy Spirit in the church from the beginning.
- The history of the Pentecostal church, the great falling away, and the restoration to Pentecost truth.
- Causes of the great falling away both primary and secondary.
- Excerpts from and discussion about Huribut's *Story of the Christian Church*.
- The Jansenists and the apostolic manifestations they experienced.
- Pentecostal power, what it does, and how far it reaches.
- The Revelation of Jesus Christ.
