## **Description/Overview:**

Exploring the realities of revival, this course outlines the principles necessary to create an atmosphere where God can move. Students will learn to practice readiness for revival.

## **Objectives:**

At the end of this course students will be able to:

- 1.) Outline the message of Mark 11:11-14.
- 2.) Clarify that one of the first aspects of revival is that it must be understood Biblically.
- 3.) State the first reality of the church as it being instrumental to the revival that God wants to bring.
- 4.) Identify the saints of God as the key players in revival.
- 5.) List the six principles of revival.
- 6.) Define real vision.
- 7.) Understand the necessity of equipping saints.
- 8.) Explain the nucleus concept.
- 9.) Explore the best use of their giftings and talents.
- 10.) Communicate some components of a balanced ministry.
- 11.) Compare organized church structures with disorganized ones.
- 12.) Illustrate the importance of weeping, fasting, and praying.

- Jesus cursing the fig tree and the message that passage holds for disciples today.
- The four principles of the harvest found in the book of Mark.
- The basis of revival which is producing healthy saints in every local church.
- Adding others to our number as the best thing we, the church, can do for Christ.
- Building the church as the work of God's Spirit.
- The four unchanging laws of leadership.
- Real vision as defined by the Scriptures.
- The mandate, motive, means, ministry, multiplication, and mentality of equipping the saints.
- The three steps of the nucleus concept.
