Pauline and General Epistles



Classroom Hours: 24 (minimum)

Description/Overview:

This course is an overview of the New Testament epistles. Students will learn the author, purpose, and general outline of each book as well as pertinent principles of Christian life found within it.

Objectives:

At the end of this course students will be able to:

1.) State the author, purpose, and background of each epistle.

- 2.) Create a general outline of each book.
- 3.) Formulate a definition of an exemplary church based on the attributes Paul commends in his writing.
- 4.) List seven practical exhortations for preparedness for God's coming.
- 5.) Select three doctrinal errors that caused the Galatians to fall from grace.
- 6.) Express Paul's twofold purpose in writing Corinthians.
- 7.) Cite three proofs of the resurrection of Christ.
- 8.) Prove the preeminence of Christ.
- 9.) Recognize four goals accomplished by Paul's writing to Titus.
- 10.) Describe appropriate conduct before God, before men, and before the church.

- Practical Christian living
- Abrahamic covenant and the purpose of the law
- The reproof and instruction of the church at Corinth
- Paul and his commission, converts, and critics

- Paul's experiences, examples, and exhortations
- Exhortations to Timothy's faithfulness
- True religion, faith, and wisdom as described in the book of James
